**NRHP or SRHP Listed Nominations**

No properties have been listed in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) or the Nevada State Register of Historic Places (SRHP) since the last Board of Museums and History Meeting.

**NRHP or SRHP Pending Nominations**

Branch No. 1, Las Vegas Grammar School / Westside School, Las Vegas, Clark County

The City of Las Vegas seeks to amend the existing nomination (NRIS 79001460) which was previously listed in the National Register of Historic Places in 1978 and amended in 2015.

Old Spanish Trail Multiple Property Documentation Form (MPDF)

In 2011, the Old Spanish Trail Association (OSTA) received contract funding from the National Park Service (NPS) and the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) administered by the New Mexico Historic Preservation Division (NM HPD) to create a Multiple Property Documentation Form (MPDF) and prepare National Register nominations for six trail segments of the Old Spanish Trail (OST). The trail segment nominations represented the diverse history and archaeology of the trail, all on BLM administered public lands because these areas exhibited the highest integrity of landscape corridors. Throughout this process six individual nominations for the trail segments were prepared to move through the nomination process under the MPDF, but the work on the MPDF was never completed.

In 2024, the Colorado SHPO finally submitted the MPDF which covers the route of the historic Old Spanish Trail and traverses the southern part of Nevada and six other western states. The respective SHPO offices and their respective state review boards have been invited to submit comments.

*The following MPDF and nomination were tabled at the Board's December 5, 2024 meeting and will be discussed at the Board's March 7, 2025 meeting:*

Historic Places Associated w/ Latinos in Nevada, 1864-2000 Multiple Property Documentation Form (MPDF), Las Vegas, Clark County

The Nevada Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration have submitted a MPDF for the Latino Project. The MPDF is a context for Latino influenced buildings, structures, events and people for the State of Nevada. This MPDF was tabled at the last BMH meeting.

Culinary Union Local 226 Headquarters Building NRHP, Las Vegas, Clark County

The Nevada Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration have submitted a single property nomination for the property at 1630 South Commerce Street, Las Vegas to the NRHP. The property is identified in the MPDF for the Latino Project. This nomination was tabled at the last BMH meeting.

**NRHP or SRHP Future Nominations and Modifications**

Las Vegas Mormon Fort (NRIS 72000764) (Additional Documentation), Las Vegas, Clark County

The City of Las Vegas seeks to amend the existing nomination of the Las Vegas Mormon Fort which was previously listed in the National Register of Historic Places in 1971 and amended in 2015. The City will be requesting the Board of Museums and History to consider the amendment during their upcoming meeting on June 5-6, 2025.

East Fourth Street Historic District, Reno Washoe County.

The City of Reno, a Certified Local Government (CLG), seeks to list a historic district in the National Register of Historic Places. This nomination will be funded through a Historic Preservation Fund (HPF) subgrant as Phase 2 of a previous architectural survey HPF subgrant.

**Federal NRHP Nominations**

Wendover Air Field (NRIS 75001827), Wendover, Elko County.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) seeks the Nevada SHPO's review to amend the existing nomination of the Wendover Air Field. As most of Wendover Air Field is in Utah and crosses into Nevada, the Utah SHPO will conduct the bulk of review.
