NRHP Listed or Pending Listing Nominations

Bethel AME Parsonage, Reno, Washoe County (NRIS 100012625).

This nomination was approved by the Board during the December 5, 2025 meeting. Listed by the Keeper in Washington D.C. in the National Register on January 26, 2026.

Las Vegas Mormon Fort (NRIS 72000764), Las Vegas, Clark County (Additional Documentation).

This amended nomination was approved by the Board during the January 23, 2026 meeting and was submitted to the Keeper in Washington D.C. for review and approval.

NRHP Pending Nominations for BMH Approval

East Fourth Street Historic District, Reno, Washoe County (new nomination).

The City of Reno seeks to list in the National Register of Historic Places the East Fourth Street Historic District (Reno). The proposed district is centered around East Fourth Street, a major transportation corridor in east-central Reno that developed from 1900 and became a Lincoln Highway segment in 1913 and cosigned as the Lincoln/Victory Highway in 1921. The district's period of significance runs from 1900 to 1974. The East Fourth Street Historic District is locally significant under Criterion A in the areas of Transportation, Commerce, and Industry as a transportation corridor that shaped Reno's industrial, commercial, and tourist activities in the early to mid-twentieth century. Commercial and industrial enterprises along the corridor were diverse, including breweries, lumber yards, warehouses, motels, restaurants and bars, grocery and liquor wholesalers, and automobile shops. The district is home to some of Reno's most remarkable early twentieth-century buildings.

Downtown Winnemucca Historic District, Winnemucca, Humboldt County (new nomination).

The city of Winnemucca seeks to list in the National Register of Historic Places the Downtown Winnemucca Historic District. Downtown Winnemucca Historic District is locally significant under Criterion A in the areas of Commerce and Community Planning and Development, with period of significance that runs from 1866 to 1968. During this time period, the district served as one of the town's primary commercial hubs, as well as an anchor of community life, with civic buildings such as the post office and library, shops, banks, bars, restaurants, and social spaces including a theater and a church. The district contains 60 resources, with a wide mix of property types, styles, and construction dates that clearly illustrate downtown Winnemucca's development and use patterns over the historic period. With 65% of the district resources contributing, the district retains sufficient overall integrity to convey its significance.

Florence Crittendon Home, Reno, Washoe County (new nomination).

The City of Reno seeks to list in both the National Register of Historic Places and the Nevada State Register of Historic Places, the Florence Crittendon Home, located at 781 Mill Street in Reno, Washoe County. The Florence Crittendon Home is eligible for listing in both registers under Criteria A, for its significance in Social History under the theme of Women's History. Its period of significance is 1919 to 1930.

SRHP Pending Nominations for BMH Approval

Log Cabin Bar, Hawthorne, Mineral County (new nomination).

The owner seeks to list in the State Register of Historic Places the Log Cabin Bar, Hawthorne, Mineral County. It is significant under Criterion C in the area of distinctive types of architecture significant to Nevada. Built in 1949, it is an example of programmatic architecture of the "log cabin" style, popularized in the 1930s. Its period of significance is 1949 to 1978.

NRHP Future Nominations for BMH Approval

Boulder City Navy Hangar, Boulder City, Clark County (new nomination).

Boulder City seeks to list in the National Register of Historic Places the Boulder City Navy Hangar, located at 1401 Boulder City Parkway in Boulder City, Clark County. The Boulder City Navy Hangar is eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places as locally significant under Criterion A, under the theme of *Military*, for the development of air power for military purposes, as the hangar was constructed by the Navy to support bi-coastal flights as part of the military buildup prior to WWII. Under Criterion C, *Architecture*, as an intact hangar that embodies the distinctive characteristics and methods of construction designed by master architect Albert Kahn through his architecture firm, Albert Kahn Associates. Its period of significance is from 1940 to 1946. This nomination may be considered during the Board's June meeting.
